President's Comments – Moment of Silence for Rep Susan Gifford & Bob Goguen. **Tuesday is Election Day!** Somerset Co Maine recommended not eating Deer or Turkey because of elevated PFAS levels being found.

Communication — A review by the RAND Corporation reveals that Extreme-Risk Protection Orders ("Red Flag") have had *inconclusive results* on various public safety outcomes. Hunters take note: State attorneys are arguing your rifles are not "constitutionally" protected in Connecticut. A stunning revelation, the FBI has quietly revised its violent crime statistics for 2022, showing a significant rise in crime that had previously been concealed. From VP Harris, "Just because you legally possess a gun in the sanctity of your locked home doesn't mean that we're not going to walk into that home and check to see if you're being responsible and safe in the way you conduct your affairs."
